**SUPPLEMENTAL CERTIFICATION OF
DEVON TYLER BARBER**
**IN SUPPORT OF RECORD
CLARIFICATION AND DUE-PROCESS
CONTEXT**

I, **Devon Tyler Barber**, of full age, hereby certify as follows:

1. I am the Plaintiff/Movant in the above-captioned matter. I submit this Certification based upon my personal knowledge and for the limited purpose of clarifying the record.
2. I submit this Certification to address prior mischaracterizations of me, beginning in or about **2022**, as a so-called “sovereign citizen” or as a person rejecting governmental authority, and to explain the procedural consequences that flowed from that mischaracterization.
3. To my knowledge, the mischaracterization first appeared in **New Jersey proceedings** in connection with police narratives and prosecutorial arguments arising from what was, in substance, a **civil landlord-tenant and wage dispute**, a fact acknowledged within the police reports themselves. Notwithstanding that acknowledgment, the matter was treated as criminal rather than civil in nature.

4. That mischaracterization was then relied upon by the State at the **detention stage**, where the prosecutor emphasized ideology-based inferences rather than objective factors such as my lawful employment history, my efforts to secure new work after the underlying civil dispute, or my ties to the community. Those mitigating facts were not presented or addressed at the detention stage.
5. As a result, I was subjected to **prolonged pretrial detention without bail**, including approximately **forty-five (45) days in solitary confinement**, under circumstances not tied to flight risk or public safety. No timely or meaningful detention review correcting the underlying assumptions was conducted.
6. During this period of detention, my ability to exercise trial-related rights was materially impaired. I was advised that the only way to secure release was to accept a plea disposition, rather than litigate detention, evidentiary, or credibility issues. Under those circumstances, the voluntariness of any plea decision was substantially affected by detention posture rather than adjudication on the merits.
7. The matters identified as **ATL-22-002313** and **ATL-22-002292** were ultimately resolved through a unified plea arrangement. Although my family retained private counsel at significant personal expense after deficiencies in appointed representation, no proper detention review or corrective motion addressing the mischaracterization was filed or litigated.
8. I do not submit this Certification to relitigate those prior matters in this forum, nor to assign fault to any individual attorney. I submit it solely to ensure that the Court does not

rely—explicitly or implicitly—on an inaccurate characterization that previously resulted in prolonged detention, loss of liberty, and erosion of core procedural protections.

9. Nothing in this Certification is intended to waive, adjudicate, or limit any claims or defenses arising from prior criminal proceedings, which are pursued through appropriate channels.

10. I have consistently and voluntarily participated in ordinary federal and state regulatory systems, including, without limitation:

- possession and use of valid United States federal identification;
- participation in state-administered licensing programs;
- registration, reinstatement, and operation of a state-recognized business entity; and
- compliance with court-ordered wage and enforcement mechanisms.

11. Attached hereto as **Exhibits A through E** are representative records demonstrating routine, lawful participation in governmental processes and civic regulation. These materials are submitted to rebut any inference that I reject governmental authority or operate outside lawful civic structures.

12. I respectfully submit this Certification to ensure that the record before this Court is accurate and that no future determinations—whether concerning credibility, detention, charging posture, or procedural treatment—are influenced by assumptions that have previously produced demonstrable due-process harm.

I certify that the foregoing statements are true. I am aware that if any statement herein is willfully false, I am subject to punishment.

Pursuant to the Division's letter of August 6, 2025, your Motion to Reopen your Hearing was Granted and per your recent settlement conference with Division staff, the Order of July 25, 2025, Revoking your Casino Employee Credential is hereby vacated. Further, per your settlement conference, you are permitted to retain your casino employee credential subject to your compliance with the enclosed Stipulation of Settlement which you have signed. Since failure to comply with any of the conditions listed in the Stipulation of Settlement could affect your ability to work in the casino industry, it is important that the terms be observed.

Furthermore, per your settlement conference, your casino employee credential is subject to your compliance with the enclosed Wage Execution Consent Agreements with South Bound Brook Municipal Court, Atlantic City Joint Municipal Court, and the Atlantic County Probation Department. The Division is aware that you are not currently employed within the New Jersey casino industry. In the event that you do become employed in the New Jersey casino industry and you still are obligated to pay these debts, you must then present the Wage Execution Consent Agreements to your New Jersey casino employer for implementation.


